


Pyramid is committed to making sure that everyone has equal access to the things we do, understanding that everybody is different, and not discriminating against people.

The entrance to Archive is via a shallow ramp.

For wide wheelchairs the door needs fully opening and staff are happy to do this.



The space is entirely on the ground floor and is accessible.




There is an all-genders accessible toilet and gender specific toilets.
