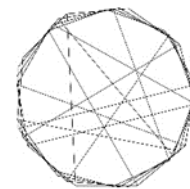




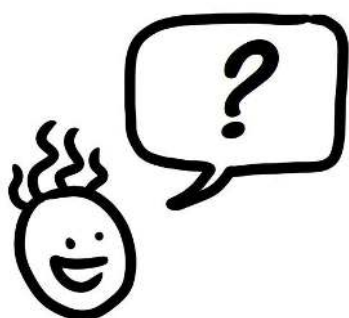

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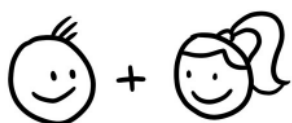

## BEYOND Development Worker (fixed-term post)



Pyramid is looking for a Development Worker to co-manage the BEYOND Artist Development Scheme (BADs).

The BEYOND Development Worker will be a person with a learning disability.



This person will work alongside another worker without a learning disability. They will work together to run the scheme.

## About the BEYOND Artist Development Scheme (BADs)



The scheme will support 4 artists to produce artwork, each over a 12 month period.

The art forms vary between visual art and performing arts.

The BADs Artists will receive funding to get 1:1 professional artist mentoring.

Each artist will be based within a different organisation.

BEYOND has agreements with other cultural organisations in Leeds to offer the BADs Artists residencies and other in-kind support.

Each BADs Artist will produce a significant piece or pieces of creative work, which will be displayed at high profile cultural locations in the city.

There will be regular events to get people together and show artwork.

The work of the 4 artists will be at the core of the 2022 BEYOND Festival.



## Responsibilities of the Development Worker

(All of this work is done alongside another Development Worker without a learning disability, as a team)

### Support the BADS Artists and help them plan projects

You will help each BADS Artist work out their programme of work.



This will involve

- deciding who their support artist/s will be
- helping them to plan their project
- working with other organisations to support them during the project
- liaising with museums, galleries and other cultural organisations that offer support to each BADS Artist

### Run events

You will organise 4 sharing events each year to highlight the work of a particular BADS artist.



This will involve lots of tasks, including

- choosing where to have the events and liaising with the venues
- agreeing how to exhibit / show the work
- marketing and invitations
- being responsible on the day

### Run meetings

You will be responsible for chairing (leading) the BEYOND steering group meetings.



## Run the website and social media



You will manage the BEYOND website and our Twitter, Instagram and Facebook profiles.

These will be used to tell the public about the BADS scheme and the BEYOND Festival.

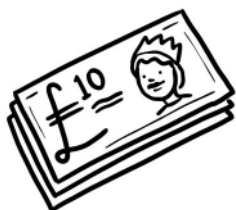
## Plan the festival



You will start planning the programme and format of the 2022 festival.

You will work out how each BADS Artist fits into it and what other events will take place to involve other artists and organisations.

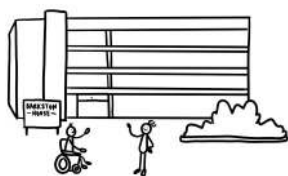
## Fundraising



You will work as part of a wider team to raise money for the 2022 festival.

## More information about the job

### Where will I be based?



We are flexible about working arrangements.

You will be provided with a workspace at Pyramid, which is in Holbeck, Leeds.

The job will involve travel to other Leeds venues for meetings.

You might need to work from home sometimes, depending on the situation with Covid-19.



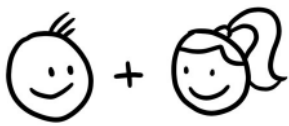
### Do I have to be good at computers?

It's useful to know how to use Zoom but if you don't it's ok. We're flexible about how the job is done and will work with you to make it accessible for you.



### How many hours per week is the job?

The job is for 14 hours per week from October 2020—June 2022 (20 months)



### Can I job share?

Yes, just tell us how you think it might work.



### What will I be paid?

The total fee is £13,734 for 0.4 fte (14 hours per week) for 20 months, paid in monthly instalments (£686.70 per month, before tax).

You can do this job as a freelancer or as a fixed-term employee of Pyramid.

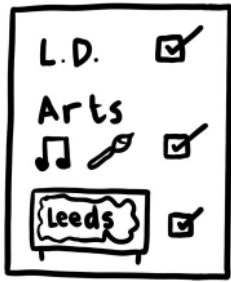


## Person Specification

This section describes the person who we want to do the job. It is really important that in your application you tell us how you fit this description.

**Essential** criteria are the things you must have, to be able to do this job

**Desirable** criteria are things that would be useful but you don't have to have them (or all of them) to apply



## Essential Criteria

- You have a learning disability
- You are enthusiastic about the arts and creativity
- You have the ability to do at least 3 of the responsibilities listed in the job description
- You are able to work in Leeds

## Desirable Criteria

- You have experience of doing other work (volunteering or paid)
- You have particular skills or experience that match the responsibilities listed in the job description
- You have experience of being an artist or creative person

## How to apply



We want you to tell us how why you think you would be suitable for the job.

You can do this in a number of ways.

We want to know about you – what sort of person are you?

We want to know about your experience and how you fit each of the criteria.

Tell us which parts of the job you could do and what you think you would be good at.



**Tell us in whatever way is comfortable and easiest for you:**

Writing – write a statement (no more than 700 words)

Audio – record yourself talking (no more than 5 mins)

Video – make a film about yourself (no more than 5 mins)

Conversation – have a conversation with someone you know and record it (no more than 5 mins)

Comic – make a comic that uses words and pictures

Phone call – arrange a time to phone one of our team and tell us – we'll record this.
